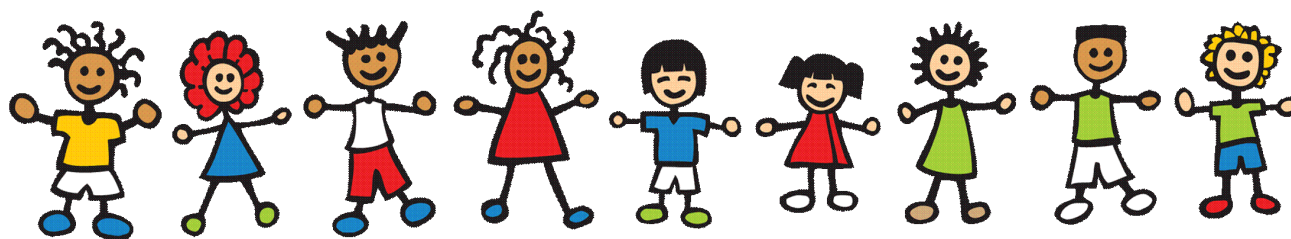


FAMILY EVENTS
